



Legislative Committee Description

The NCAAA Legislative Affairs Committee is responsible for evaluating and monitoring proposed legislation and regulations that may impact African Americans in Nebraska, both positively and negatively. The committee will regularly report its findings and recommendations to the full Commission as necessary.

Key Responsibilities include:

Monitoring and Evaluation: Review and evaluate all proposed legislation and regulations that may favorably or adversely affect African Americans in Nebraska and report as frequently as necessary to the Commission.

Outreach: Coordinate meetings with Senators, attend hearings, and solicit public testimony in their official capacity on behalf of the Commission.

Legislative Agenda Development: Develop the Commission's annual legislative agenda.

Public Testimony Preparation: As appropriate provide input on relevant points to address in preparation for public testimony; however, the overall presentation will be at the discretion of the Commission member testifying.

Reporting and Communication: The Legislative Affairs Chair or Vice Chair will be responsible for all communication to the Executive Committee and full Commission including presenting any reports that need to be shared at Commission meetings.
