Pursuant to [Nebraska Revised Statutes Section 84-1411](#), notice is hereby given to members of the Nebraska Commission on African American Affairs Commission and the public that a general meeting of the Commission will be held on **Wednesday, April 22, 2026** from **4:30 – 6:30PM**. The meeting will be held at the **Nebraska State Office Building, 301 Centennial Mall S, Lincoln, NE 68508, in the Otoe Room on the Lower Level.**

Pursuant to [Nebraska Revised Statutes Section 84-1413 \(4\)](#), this notice hereby notifies members of the Nebraska Commission on African American Affairs Commission and the public that the minutes of all meetings, as well as any evidence and documentation presented or disclosed during open sessions, are considered public records. These records are available for public inspection during normal business hours: Monday through Friday, 8:00 AM – 5:00 PM at the Commission's principal office, located at: 1327 H Street, Suites 306-308, Lincoln, Nebraska 68508. Members of the public may also visit the Commission's office, or contact them over the phone at 402-471-9398 or via email at ncaaa.contact@nebraska.gov to request copies of meeting agendas or access them online via the Commission's website.

Pursuant to [Neb. Rev. Stat. § 84-1410\(1\)](#), the Commission may vote to enter Executive Session, which is not open to the public, for the purpose of receiving legal advice or discussing sensitive personnel matters related to items on the agenda.

Pursuant to Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) the Office of the Governor does not discriminate on the basis of disability regarding admission to public meetings.
