Pursuant to Nebraska Revised Statutes Section 84-1411, notice is hereby given to members of the Nebraska Commission on African American Affairs Commission and the general public that the Commission will hold a special meeting, open to the public at 11:00 AM on Tuesday, May 14, 2024. The meeting will be held at the State Capitol, 1445 K St, Lincoln, NE 68508, Room 1510. The meeting will be recorded for public access. The meeting agenda is readily available for public inspection at the Commission's principal office located at 1327 H Street, Suites 306-308, Lincoln Nebraska during normal business hours. Pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. Section 84-1410(1), the Commission may vote to go into Executive Session, which will not be open to the public, for legal advice or sensitive personnel discussions concerning any item on the agenda.
